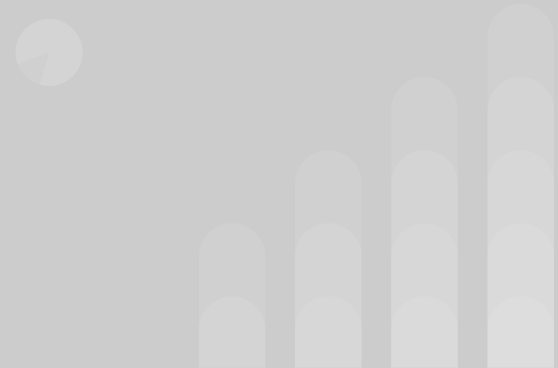
rosario must face her fears about letting her voice be heard.
