

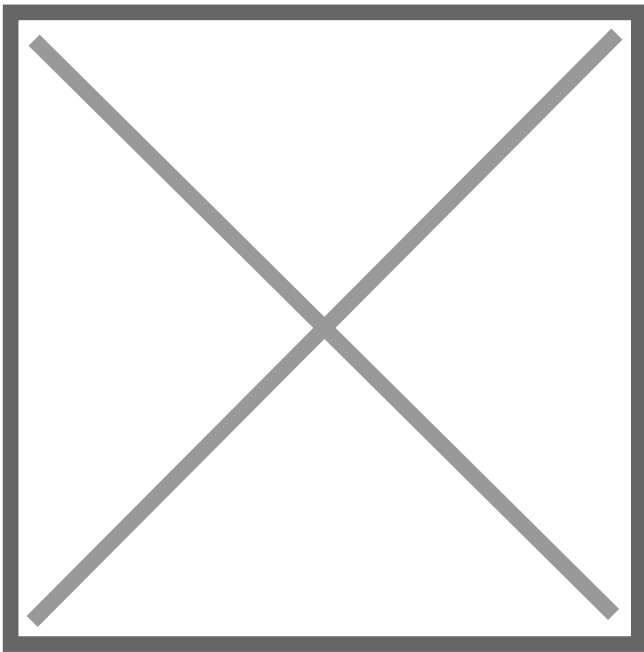
TeachingBooks

TeachingBooks (K-Grade 12) is an online database that explores children's books and young adult literature. The database provides access to additional materials (e.g., short movies, audio book readings, book discussion guides) to enhance learning, including the following features:

- Meet authors and illustrators with exclusive movies and recordings
- Experience thousands of read-along audiobook performances
- Hear authors pronounce and tell the stories of their names
- Enjoy almost 2,000 complete book recordings
- Explore book trailers, Meet-the-Author recordings, and more
- Support assignments about books and author studies
- Find the right book for you (Reader's Advisory)
