

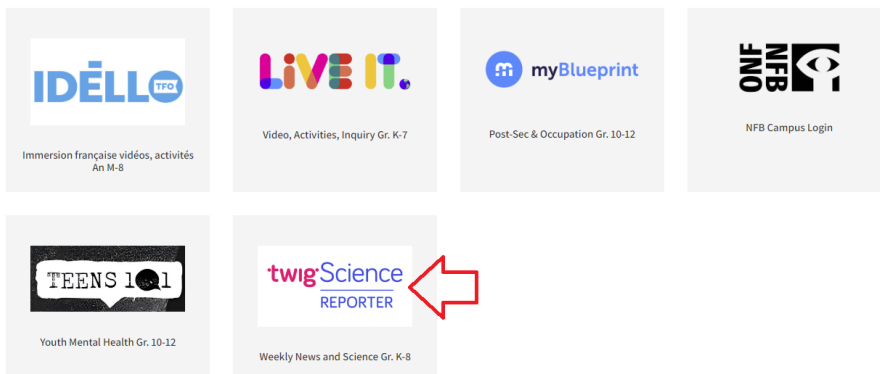
# Twig Science Reporter
