


World Watch News

Logging In

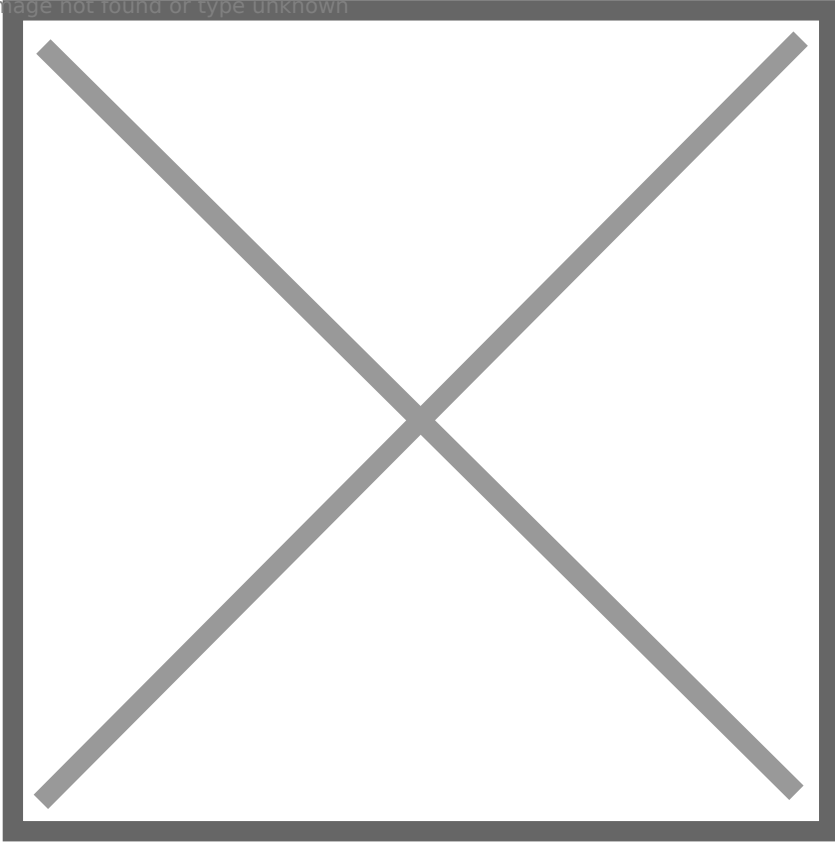
